Members may submit **up to three images**, either prints, projected digital images (PDI), or a combination of both.

Thursday 11 February

Image Appraisal 5 – Set Subject ‘CREATIVE’

Members may submit **up to three images**, either prints, projected digital images (PDI), or a combination of both.

This season's technical challenge invites members to create an original image derived entirely from one or more of their own photographs. There are no restrictions on style or genre, encouraging imagination, experimentation and innovative image-making.

All component images must be the photographer's own work. AI-generated imagery, clip art or externally sourced material is not permitted.

Assessor – Paul Bradley

Paul Bradley is an accredited Level 3 SCPF judge and former Chairman of Niton & District Camera Club. During his thirteen years leading the club it achieved consistent success within the SCPF League. Paul remains an active judge, recognised for his knowledgeable and encouraging approach.

Members may submit **up to three images**, either prints, projected digital images (PDI), or a combination of both.

This year's creative theme encourages photographers to capture not simply smiling faces, but the moments, places and experiences that evoke genuine happiness. Members are encouraged to think beyond the obvious and consider images that tell a story or communicate emotion.

Thoughtful image titles may help reinforce your interpretation of the theme.

Bob Hart is an accredited Level 2 SCPF judge and long-standing member of Winchester Photographic Society. His photography encompasses landscapes, architecture, monochrome, transport and events, while his judging style combines technical knowledge with an appreciation of creativity, delivered with warmth, humour and encouragement.
